An important message for all parents.

The Legislative enactment of the Education Act (1989) and the Education Regulations (1989) in Queensland requires that a Register of membership of the association be maintained.

This is an **IMPORTANT ASPECT** of the Education Act.

Only persons who are registered members of the P & C Association can be covered/protected while working at the school in any capacity.

In effect

- This means that helpers in the tuckshop **DO** need to be on the register of the P & C.
- Parents who attend any of the meetings at the school, or who assist in any duties for the teachers/with the teachers in classrooms, excursions etc. **DO** need to be registered.
- A parent can not become an officer bearer without first becoming a registered P & C member.
- Unless a parent attending a meeting of the P & C or any of its sub committees is on the register of the P & C that person has no voting right for any of the decisions made or taken.
- All helpers at working bees, future fetes, hotel ticket sellers etc. will be required to be registered P & C Association members.

It is very important that you give serious consideration to this message and help our association by responding to registration promptly.

Registration of membership is an **ANNUAL** requirement.

The secretary of the P & C Association has the task of keeping the Register current. To assist him/her in this duty, this letter is being forwarded to all families, with the request that the attachment seeking membership is completed and returned to the school office.
