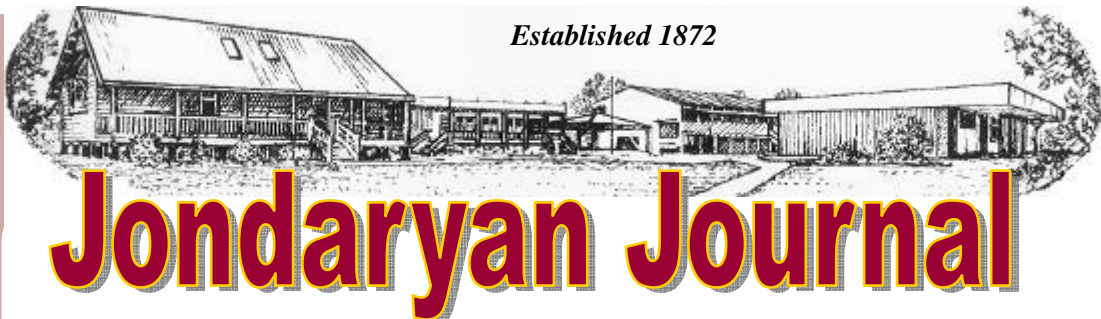

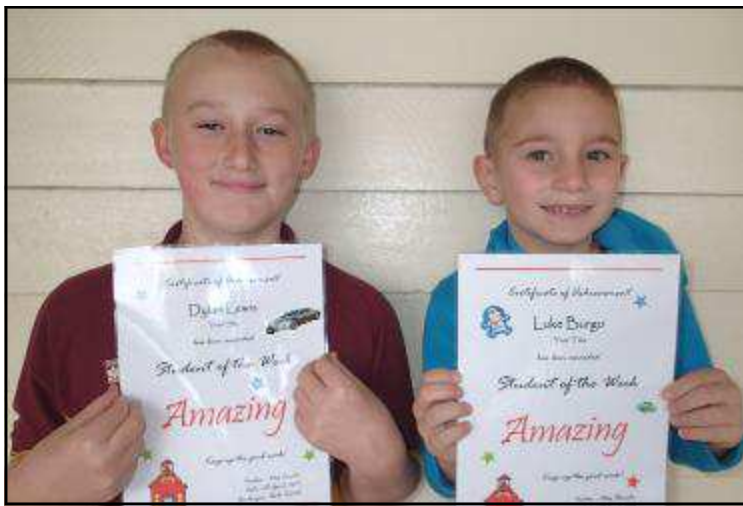

*Week Two Miss Stansbie gave Student of the Week to **Luke** for working really hard in Science and Language.*

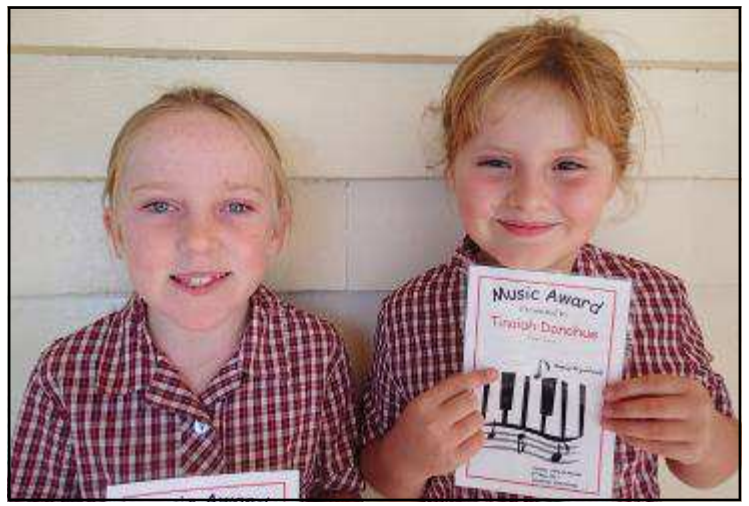

This week the music awards went to **Ruby** in Prep-3 class and **Kiran** in 4-6 class. Nicely done girls!

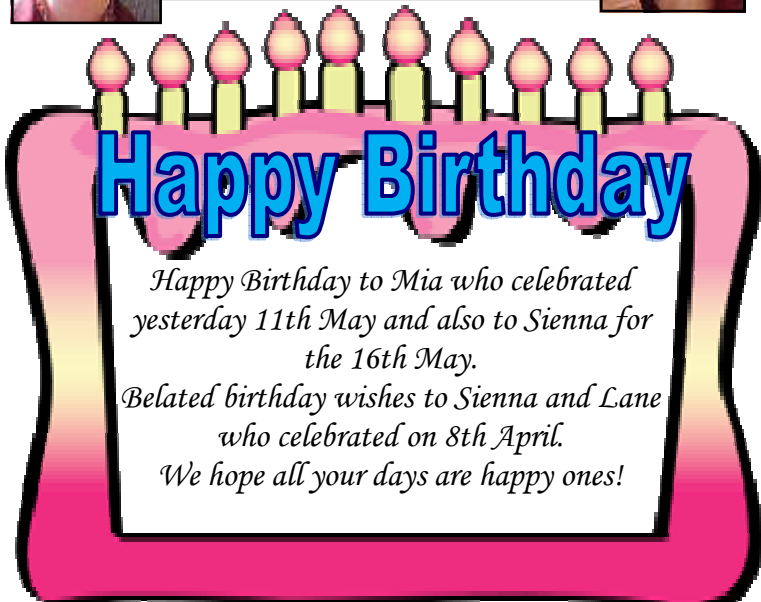


RAFFLE—Week Two the raffle was won by **Harmony** for being responsible and keeping others safe.
