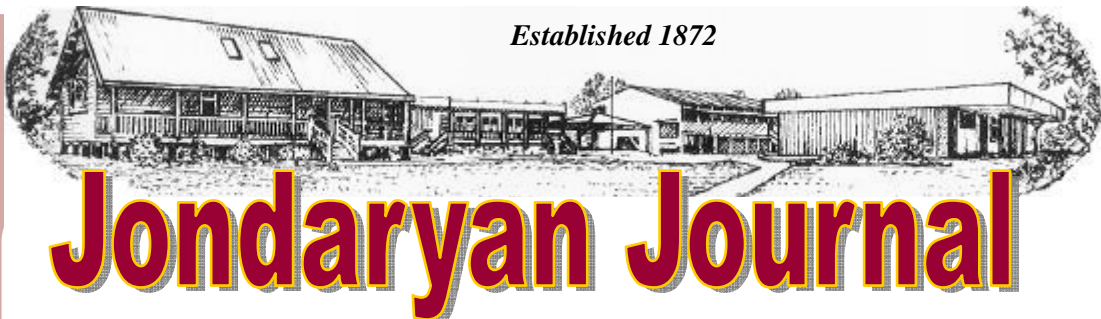

We are over half way through term 2. Students are working hard on their assessments, so it's more important than ever that students are at school every day to ensure they are participating in all of these learning opportunities.

Last Friday, the year 4 to 6 student's travelled out to Dalby to participate in the Touch Football carnival. While the weather was not the best, thanks to the quick thinking of the organisers they managed to secure the PCYC Hall! Our students had a great time learning touch football skills and interacting with other students. Unfortunately the day had to end early because of the rain, but they still enjoyed the day.

On Monday we had members from the PCYC come to our school. We all participated in their indigenous sport program. Students played a variety of team sports with different staff members. All of our students had a wonderful time!

On Tuesday Harmony Lewis and Jack Wilson travelled to Toowoomba to participate in the Darling Downs Cross Country Trials. This is a huge achievement for these two students. They both did a fantastic job. Each race had around 50 of the best cross country runners from the region participating. Harmony placed 18th and Jack placed 27th we would like to congratulate these students on their amazing work!

Today we had a visit from the RSPCA van EMU. The EMU van focussed on key animal welfare issues. The students viewed audio-visual presentations discussing our impact on the environment and highlighting specific threats to wildlife. They used the fully-equipped vet centre with x ray box and microchip scanner. This will encourage our students to take their pets to the vet for regular checks. We also checked out the wildlife dioramas. We had a great time and the students enjoyed their hands on experience.

On the 7th of June our students will be attending Dalby Eisteddfod. They will be competing with other small schools in the area and singing two songs. Our students have been practicing very hard with Mrs de Nooyer each week and are sounding great. We will be catching a bus to the Eisteddfod, it will leave our school at 9:15am. We will sing in our section and have lunch at the nearby park. Students will need to wear full school uniform. For the boys this means maroon shirts and shorts with black shoes and the girls will wear their maroon and white dresses with black shoes. If you do not own part of the uniform you will need to contact the school to arrange it. Parents are welcome to come and watch us compete. There is an entry fee. We will be performing at around 10:00 am. This time could change due to delays on the day.

Our students have been busy practicing for our upcoming athletics carnival. They have been working hard in lunch breaks, afterschool, during sports lessons and with their class teachers. They have been putting in a huge effort practicing their skills. I have been exceptionally impressed with how well our students have been doing with high jump. Everyone is really looking forward to this year's carnival. Please make sure all students clothing is named so owners can be found. We would like to thank all the staff who have worked so hard with the kids and organising the carnival. It is sure to be a great one. We would also like to thank Andrew and Chris Baartz for marking the lines for us. The athletics carnival will be held on the 9th of June and we look forward to seeing you all there!

**RAFFLE**-This week the raffle was won by **Leshay** for great writing when practising for NAPLAN.

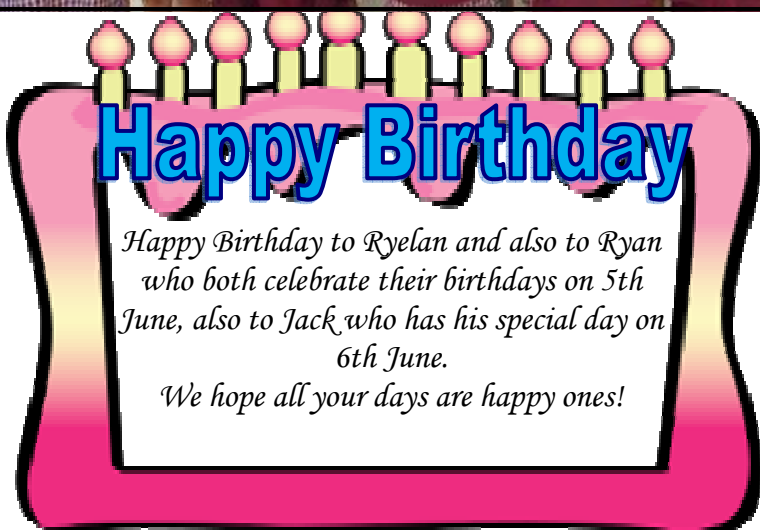
**MATHLETICS AWARDS**
