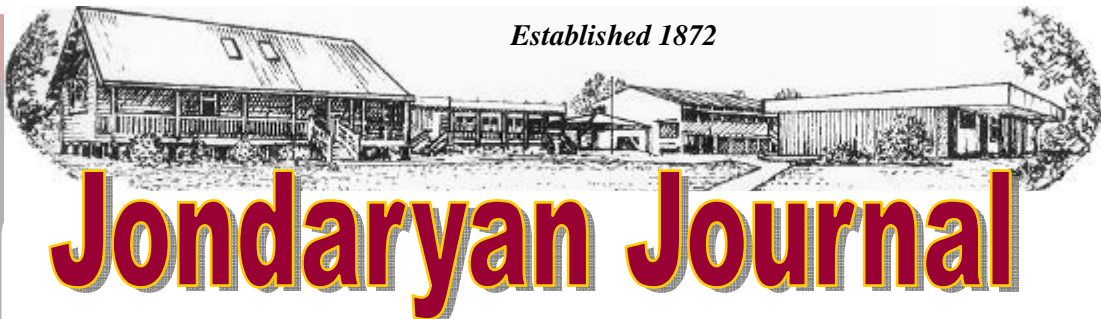

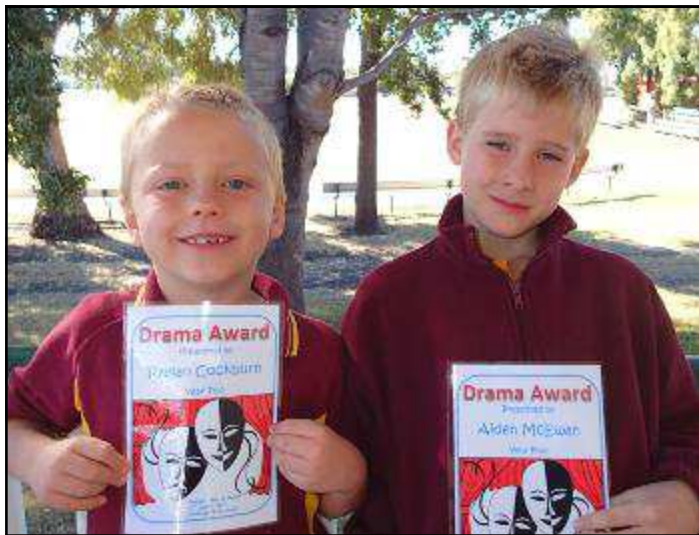
This week Miss Stansbie presented her award to **Ryelan** for his amazing work in Maths especially his great effort board maths.

**Before and after school procedures:** Our school hours are 8:50am to 3:00pm.

The school gates will be locked until the bus arrives at 8:15am. Students will then be required to sit underneath the school until 8:30am. They will then be free to play until the bell goes at 8:50am.

After school students who do not catch the bus, will be required to sit down at the gate on the seats provided, until they are collected either by parents or older siblings, depending on the arrangements made by their families. This of course is not the case on days we provide after school sport.
